The Campership Incentive Program, supported by the UJA-Federation of New York, The Foundation for Jewish Camping, and The Jewish Communal Fund aims to strengthen and build Jewish identity by attracting new campers between the ages of 8 and 16 (as of June 1st) to attend Jewish sleep away camps, like Camp Eisner and Crane Lake, regardless of financial need.



Studies have shown that having a Jewish camping experience is highly correlated with creating a strong Jewish adult identity. The Campership Incentive Program offers grants for overnight Jewish camping and enriches children so they will come away with a renewed appreciation and lifetime enjoyment of Judaism.

- Children attending a Jewish camp for the first time (3 weeks or longer) will receive \$1,250.
